Power of Attorney.

Earle my true and lawful Attorney, for me and in my name and stead to receive and receipt for any and all money, notes and other property, of every nature and kind, due and that may be due to me hereafter from time to time from a partnership heretofore existing under the name of R.K. Earle and Company and also from the estate of Theron Earle, deceased.

And I do hereby authorize and empower my said attorney in my name and stead to lend from time to time such money as he may collect for me, taking such security as he may deem best, and from time to time to receive payments thereon, issue receipts therefor, cancel mortgages and other security that may be given me from time to time, and generally to do all such other acts and things as may be right and proper as my Attorney in fact in handling for me all moneys so collected and in investing the same from time to time, as notes may be paid and mortgages or other evidences of indebtedness may need to be surrendered and cancelled. All which authority I hereby give and grant unto my said Attorney in Fact as fully and completely to execute in my name and stead as if I were personally present to attend to the same.
