I give and bequeath the portraits of Mr and Mrs Mordecai Cohen to Inez Cohen Pollak and Dr - Frances Cohen, or such one of them, as shall be living at my death. If, however, neither be living at my death, the said portraits shall become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property and be disposed of, as is hereinafter provided with respect to the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and property.

I give and bequeath one dozen large silver spoons, twenty one large silver forks, twenty small silver spoons, one pair of silver tongs, two silver salt cellars on four little round knobs, one silver skillet with cover, one silver cheese-spoon, two gold lined silver jelly dishes, shell finished, two silver gravy spoons, shell finished (being silver coming originally from the Cohen family) to Inez Cohen Pollak and Fanny Cohen daughters of the late D.D. Cohen, or such of them as shall be living at my death, to be divided between them as nearly, as may be, if both be living at my death, but if neither of them be living at my death, the said articles bequeathed to said Inez Cohen Pollak and Fanny Cohen, shall become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property, and shall be disposed of as is hereinafter provided with respect to the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property.

I give, bequeath order and direct, that one diamond pin solitaire and diamond set be sold, after expert valuation, and the proceeds of sale be turned into my General Estate and become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property and be disposed of as is hereinafter provided with respect to the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property.

I give and bequeath to my sister Rosetta Hart all my clothing, wearing apparel, books, Pictures, beds, bedding, linen and all my household furniture and effects of every kind, except such as may be herein otherwise bequeathed, and also all my jewelry and silver not otherwise disposed of by this my last Will and Testament. If, however, she be not living at my death, the same shall become and be a part of the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and property and be disposed of, as is hereinafter provided with respect to the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and property.

I give and bequeath five thousand dollars to my nephew Davis Lopez Hart.

I give and bequeath one thousand dollars to my sister Rosetta Hart.

I give and bequeath five hundred dollars to my brother Nathan S. Hart.

I give and bequeath five hundred dollars to Mrs. Ada Hart wife of my brother Nathan S. Hart.

I give and bequeath five hundred dollars to my nephew Morris S. Hart.

I give and bequeath five hundred dollars to Rosalie Hart widow of Israel Hart.

I give and bequeath five hundred dollars to Priscilla, Dorothy and Caro, daughters of S.N. Hart or such one or more of them, as shall be living at my death, in equal shares, if more than one, and if only one the whole to that one.

I give and bequeath to each of the daughters of my brother Nathan S. Hart namely Fanny Hart and Nina Hart, two hundred and fifty dollars.

I give and bequeath to Maria DeLeon Nordia, daughter of the late H.H. DeLeon all my laces of -

every kind and description and also three hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath one hundred dollars to my friend Miss Margaret Moffett sister of George H. - Moffett hereinafter mentioned.

I give and bequeath one hundred dollars to Miss Mary Johnston Buist daughter of Dr. J. Somers Buist.

I give, devise bequeath order and direct, that should any of the persons to whom I have given money legacies by this my last Will and Testament, die before me, then and in such case, the legacy or legacies hereinbefore given to such person or persons, so dying before me, shall become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property and be disposed of, as in hereinafter provided with respect to the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property, except as to the legacy of five thousand dollars given to my nephew David Lopez Hart, as to which I make the following disposition namely; if the said David Lopez Hart should die before me, then and in that case, I give and bequeath the said sum of five thousand dollars to his wife Mrs. Laura Hart, if she be living at my death, but if neither said David Lopez Hart nor his said wife Mrs. Laura Hart be living at my death, then and in such case I give and bequeath order and direct that said sum of five thousand dollars shall become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property and be disposed of, as is hereinafter provided with respect to the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property. And further, in case Maria Cohen Nordia should die before me, then and in such case, I give, bequeath order and direct that my laces hereinbefore given to her shall become and be a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate and property and be disposed of as in hereinafter provided with respect to the rest residue and remainder of my Estate and property.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my entire Estate and property, real, personal, and of every kind and description and wheresoever situate, I give, devise and bequeath to Miss Rosetta Hart, Mrs. Laura Hart, George H. Moffett and J.N. Nathans Jr. and the survivors and survivor of them in Trust to invest and keep the same invested, with power of sale for investment and Reinvestment, and to apply the net income thereof as follows: to wit; to the payment thereof to the following persons, namely Catherine Hart, Isabel Hart, Mary C. Hart, Ida Hart daughters of my brother Daniel Hart, and D. Frances Cohen of New York, that is to say one fifth of said net income to each of them, during their or her respective lives or life; and in case of the death of any one or more of them, before or after me, the portion of said net income coming to them or her so dying before or after me, shall become and be held by said Trustees or the survivors or survivor of them as an addition to the corpus; And further in Trust on the death of the survivor of them the said Catherine Hart, Isabel Hart, Mary C. Hart, Ida Hart and Dr. - Frances Cohen, to turn over and pay over the said rest, residue and remainder of my said Estate and property real, personal and of every kind and description and wheresoever situate with all accumulations thereof to "The Winthrop Normal and Industrial College of South Carolina" to be invested and kept by it invested, with power of sale for investment and reinvestment, the net income to be used and applied by it to the tuition and maintenance at said College of poor and deserving woman, citizens or the daughters of citizens of the State of South Carolina and Preferably of the City of Charleston, under such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by said College.
