McWhite shall consent in writing to some other form of investment), and at their discretion to change and vary investments from time to time and as often as they may desire; this power of sale and re-investment not to be exhausted by one use thereof, but to continue as long as the trust estate endures, and to be exercised repeatedly if necessary; with as full power to sell and convey subsequently acquired property as the property herein described; and in trust to pay to the said William B. McWhite, during the full term of his natural life, all of the net income arising from the proceeds of sale of the said 21-1/2 acre tract up to the sum of Three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per annum; and to pay over and distribute to and among the said Ellen McWhite Johnson, Ethel McWhite Ray and Annie Belle-McWhite share and share alike, freed of all trusts, all of the net income thereon in excess of the three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per annum; and in trust, upon the death of the said William B. McWhite, to pay over and distribute to and among the said Ellen McWhite Johnson, Ethel McWhite Ray and Annie Belle McWhite, share and share alike, freed of all trusts the principal fund, to-wit: the net proceeds of sale of the said 21-1/2 acre tract.

And it is further understood and agreed that the respective share or shares of the said Ellen McWhite Johnson, Ethel McWhite Ray and Annie Belle McWhite, or any one or more of them who shall die leaving issue shall vest in such issue, respectively, per stirpes; and that the respective share or shares of any one or more of the three persons last above named who may die leaving no issue shall vest in her or their sister or sisters and in the respective issue, per stirpes of such of her or their sisters as may have previously died leaving issue.
