It is understood that upon the withdrawal of the said statements, all prosecutions against Mrs. Mary C. Douglas is to cease and be withdrawn, and that she does hereby pay the costs incurred in this matter.

The powers and authorities herein given and granted shall as to all parties dealing with my said Attorney, continue and remain in full force and effect unless and until such parties shall have actual notice of the revocation of this instrument or until revocation of the same be filed and recorded in the office of the R.L.C. for Greenville County, S.C.

In case of my death, this instrument and all transactions by my attorney hereunder shall as to all parties without actual notice of my death be valid and of full force and virtue and binding upon my heirs and legal representatives.
