Whereas, I, Mrs Annie Blankenship, a resident of the State and County aforesaid, am the mother of a male child about nine months old named James B. Blankenship;

And, whereas, my husband, John Blankenship, the father of said child left me for part unknown, and I am so situated as not to be able to properly rear, care for, and educate said child;

And Whereas, M. J. & Myrtle Johnson are citizens and residents of said County and State, of good moral character and able to care for and educate said child;

Now, Therefore, I, the said Annie Blankenship, in consideration of the premises and the sum of One Dollar to me in hand paid by the said M. J. and Myrtle Johnson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, disposed of and transferred, and by these presents do grant, dispose of and transfer the custody, care, education, maintenance and support of my said child, James B. Blankenship, to the said M. J. and Myrtle Johnson, and their heirs, until my said child shall arrive at the age of twenty-one years.

Together with all the rights, privileges, powers and duties of care, education and control of my said child until he reaches the age of twenty-one years, to the said M. J. and Myrtle Johnson and their heirs as fully and completely as I myself had before this conveyance was executed, in accordance with the provisions of the Statutes of this State in such cases made and provided.
