Case, in consideration of love and affection for my child hereinafter named and in view of my own inability to provide for his necessary comfort, support and education and because of the confidence I repose in my friends and relatives F. M. Morris and his wife Tilda Morris, do agree as follows: That I do hereby forever relinquish and transfer to the said F. M. Morris and his wife Tilda Morris the right of service, custody and control of my child, named Walter Edgar Case, eleven years old until said child be twenty-one years of age or until he shall sooner marry or become engaged in some suitable employment by and with the consent of the said F. M. Morris and Tilda Morris.

That said F. M. Morris and Tilda Morris shall have the right to control and designate the custody and service of said child. In view of the fact that I am unable to properly support and educate him myself I stipulate that said child shall receive such instruction in useful trades as is suitable for people in his position in life and hereby forever relinquish full and right of custody to control service, companionship or other incident to the relation parent.

I hereby transfer and surrender to the said F. M. Morris and Tilda Morris in consideration of the premises all the rights, privileges and benefits that accrued to me as parent and establish them absolutely in loco-parentis.
