This agreement made and entered into this tenth day of December, 1923 by and between E. M. Wharton and Dr. Hugh Smith.

Witness that E. M. Wharton has leased to Dr. Hugh Smith, who has hired and taken the same, the entire rear of second floor of the building located in the City of Greenville, known as 326 and 328 N. Main Street and the Cushman Building.

In the event of fire, if the damage shall amount to fifty per cent of the value of the building, either party may cancel this lease by written notice.

The tenant agrees to make good all damages to the premises, its fixtures and equipment, during the tenancy; due to the negligence of himself, his servants or agents, or persons on the premises expressed or implied, the roof excepted, which the landlord agrees to keep in good condition.

Dr. Hugh Smith agrees not to sublet or any portion thereof without the written permission of the landlord.

Dr. Hugh Smith further agrees to accept this lease and its covenants and to pay therefor to E. M. Wharton a rental of sixty-five dollars per month, beginning January the first 1924 for five years ending December the thirty-first 1929. The said rent to be paid monthly in advance the first day of each month.

It is mutually understood that the center hall may be used as a joint reception room for the surrounding offices.

It is further agreed that E. M. Wharton shall provide heat and water for these premises during the term of this tenancy.

It is further mutually agreed that the suite of offices on the front north side will not be leased to a tenant who does not meet the approval of Dr. Hugh Smith.

In witness thereof E. M. Wharton and Dr. Hugh Smith has hereunto set their hand and seal this the tenth day of December, 1923.
