Whereas, Elsie Maloy is desirous of committing the care, maintenance, education and support of her child Frank Taylor to Wilton F. Hawkins and Costa Hawkins;

And, Whereas, the said Wilton F. Hawkins and Costa Hawkins agree to accept the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of the said Frank Taylor during his minority, and further agree that they will, by proper devise and bequest, make him equal with their own children in the distribution of their estate, and that they will further hold and manage all of the property of the said Frank Taylor and the increase thereof for his separate use until he shall have married or arrived at the age of twenty-one years. Now, Therefore,

Know All Men By These Presents, That I, Elsie Maloy for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, maintenance, education and support of my child Frank Taylor born on the 26th day of July, A. D. 1914, to Wilton F. + Costa Hawkins for and during his minority.

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me as parent, over and in respect to the said Frank Taylor.

To Have and to Hold, the said Frank Taylor against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through me in and to the said Frank Taylor.

Witness my hand and seal this 7th day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Four and in the One Hundred forty-eighth Year of the Independence of the United States of America.
