Brockman, Surveyor, Aug 24, 1930, and having the following courses and distances, metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at iron pin on Miller Street, corner lot #1, and runs thence with said street N. 17-00 E. 67 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-40 E. 109.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43-12 E. 49.1 feet to iron pin or stone, corner Dr. Frierson and also corner lot #3; thence S. 74-19 E. 88.5 feet to an iron pin, Dr. Frierson and Greer Furniture corners; thence with Greer Furniture line S. 29-36 W. 50 feet to iron pin, corner lot #1; thence with line of lot #1 N. 12-37 W. 231.7 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of the lands conveyed to L.
