Wood and in consideration of the sum of \$500 to us in hand paid by the said David W. Wood, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said David W. Wood all our right, title and interest which we may now have or which we may in any manner hereafter acquire under item three of the will above referred to, in and to the following described premises:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles east of the city of Greenville on the Lowndes Hill Road, adjoining lands now or formerly belonging to H. C. Markley and Jack Elijah, containing between forty and fifty acres and being the same tract of land devised to the said David W. Wood by the will of John W. Wood recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate for Greenville County in Will Book "4", page 107-110."

We further transfer and assign to the said David W. Wood any interest which we may have or which we may hereafter acquire under item three of said will in the proceeds from the sale of said land.
