Whereas the parties hereto did on 24th February 1925 enter into a written agreement appointing R. E. Dalton and D. A. Hussey as arbitrators to locate same and establish the lines between said parties and

Whereas said arbitrators have filed a plat locating said lines which plat has been recorded in P. M. S. office for Greenville County in plat book F. page 174.

It is therefore the parties hereto mutually agree that the following shall be the lines between their respective properties where said properties adjoin:

Beginning at a pipe and corner on land of L. P. Mice; thence N. 5-30 W. 95.0 feet to a pipe and stone joint corner between the parties hereto; thence S. 60-12 W. 151.4 feet to iron pin; thence N. 70-55 W. 122.0 feet to iron pin; thence N. 67-30 W. 111.5 feet to iron pin; in old road; thence with center of said road S. 27-42 W. 136.4 feet to pipe and stone in old road; thence due west with said old road 200.5 ft. to a pipe and stone in road; the said lines being shown on the plat hereinabove referred to and recorded.
