

State of South Carolina, } Deed of separation
County of Greenville }

This agreement made this and day of July 1926 by
and between John D. Sullivan of this & Co. party of the
first part; Lucia Priestley Sullivan, of Taylors, S.C.
party of the second part witnesseth:

Civil and all other legal disputes have arisen between said husband
and wife on account of which they are separated
and now live apart and intend to live apart from each
other during the remainder of their natural life.

And therefore we covenanted adjustment and in
compromise of all property questions and rights to the
said husband does hereby assign, convey, transfer
and set over unto said wife fifty (\$50.00) Dollars as
an undivided one-half interest in a certain Buick Automobile
now owned by him and his by his good and sufficient
cause of his inability conveyed unto Plaintiff Priestley,
or Trustee the following described property:

An undivided one-half interest by and to
all that certain piece of land situate
by me and being in the State of South Carolina County
of Greenville Sim's Creek Springs Township near the
National Highway in the Town of Taylors and
having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at a stake on the old Buck Springs
Road, corner of lot no. 31 and runs thence by N. 60 E. 50
feet to a stake on the said road, corner of lot no. 34;
thence S. 33 E. 19 feet to a stake thence S. 11 E. 11.50
feet to a stake thence N. 86 W. 19.50 feet to the begin-
ning corner and being the same lots purchased by
me from J. G. Foster on April 15th 1924 said deed
being recorded in the Register Office for the County
and state aforesaid in Vol. 195 page 301.

We further stipulate that the said trustee
shall convey the same to said wife in consideration
that said wife doth hereby release and discharge said
husband from all obligation of support and from all other
claims, rights and duties arising out of said marital
relation. Said parties mutually agree that each may
freely sell or otherwise dispose of his or her
property by gift deed or will without in any wise
incurvelling the rights of the other and each party
is hereby barred from any and all rights by way
of dower, inheritance, descent, distribution or any
rights that may arise out of said property.

And each party releases and relinquishes to
the other and to their heirs, executors, adminis-
trators and assigns thereof all rights or rights of

dower or inheritance in and to all real property of the
other either now owned or hereafter acquired.

The party of the second part doth hereby agree to
withdraw the civil proceedings instituted and served
upon the party of the first part of this date in the
form or nature of an attachment against the above
described premises and the car aforesaid mentioned
and all property therein now owned by the party
of the first part and the party of the second part
further agrees that she will not institute any
criminal proceedings of any kind arising out of
facts upon which this agreement is based.

Each party agrees that the above described
premises shall be sold within the usual and consent
of each of their attorneys and it shall be the au-
thority and consent of each of their attorneys and
when sale is made the party of the first part
agrees that the party of the second part shall
have fifty (\$50.00) Dollars more than the share of
the party of the first part, said fifty (\$50.00) Dollars
being for his one-half interest in the above mentioned
car.

Each party also agrees upon request of the other
to execute and acknowledge for and all deeds or
instrument of release or conveyance in order to
enable such other to sell convey or otherwise dis-
pose of his or her own real property, the said
one apparent right or otherwise.
