This agreement made between Mrs. Claude Harrison, individually, as administratrix of the estate of W.B. Harrison, deceased and as guardian for the minor children of herself and W.B. Harrison, deceased, hereinafter called Landlord, party of the first Part, and Moore & McBee a partnership consisting of L.J. McBee, Sr., G.J. Moore and H.B. McBee, hereinafter called Tenants, parties of the second part, witnesseth:-

1. That the Landlord does hereby lease to the Tenants, their heirs and assigns, for a term of three years from date of this lease the premises at the north-west corner of Laurens Street and McBee Avenue, now occupied by Green Milling Station, said property formerly belonging to W.B. Harrison, deceased, together with the buildings and appliances thereon situated at a rental of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month for the first year and two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month for the second and third years, said rent to be paid monthly at the end of each and every month hereafter.

2. The tenants agree to rent said premises for the said term and pay the rental as hereinabove set forth promptly as it becomes due, and further agrees to surrender said premises at the end of said term to the Landlord.
