J. Strangier, his heirs and assigns all those two certain lots of land in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, known as lots Number Ninety-two and Ninety-three (92 and 93) on plat of the land of B. J. Martin, by L. M. Turnam, surveyor from Survey of J. A. Schulz, known as West View said plat, recorded in Office of R. M. L. Greenville County, State of South Carolina, plat book 3 page 140, tract of the said lots having a frontage of sixty-one (61) feet on King Street and running back one hundred and fifty (150) feet with a back lane of fifty feet as shown on said plat.

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
