All that piece parcel or lot of land, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, on the west side of Grove Road, known as a portion of lot no. B in plat of P. E. Dalton, Engineer, made February 1925 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pipe on the west side of Grant Road, which pipe is 230 feet from the southwest intersection of Grove Road and the sixty-foot unnamed street, thence N. 64° 23' W. 68.6 feet to iron pipe in line of Miles property, thence along Miles line S. 32° 45' W. 71.1 feet to iron pipe at corner of lot no. C, thence with line of lot no. C, S. 64° 23' E. 13.5 feet to iron pipe in Grade road, thence along the west side of Grove road N. 19° 19' 70 feet to the beginning corner.
