pipe at the northwest corner of Bennett Street and Swiss Avenue; thence along the west
side of Bennett Street N. 19-30 E. 71 ft. to an iron pipe; thence at right angles to
Bennett Street N. 70-30 W. 165 ft. to an iron pipe on rear; thence along rear along
property of H. K. Townes, Trustee, S. 19-30 W. 58 ft. to an iron pipe on the north side
