I, Arthur T. Norwood, do hereby acknowledge, have Inacted Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
 Sallie J. Arnold and her heirs and assigns,  
 the tract of land or tract of land situate, lying  
 and being in the state of South Carolina and County of Greenville  
 on White Horse road, near Welcome Church, containing twelve  
 acres, more or less, known as tract no. 16 on Plat recorded in the  
 Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and  
 State in Plat Book 6, at Page 165, and having, according to said  
 Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: - Beginning at a  
 stone 30 ft. on White Horse road, and running thence with  
 said road N. 39° W. 10.15 chains to a stone on said road, on the  
 corner of Welcome Church Property; thence along the Staunton  
 Stage road approximately E. 15° N. about 17.27 chains to a stone  
 300 ft. on East Mountain road; thence along Mrs. Hughes line S.  
 33° 13' 1/2 E. about 30 ft. on Mrs. Charles line; thence  
 along her line N. 35° 13' 27" chains to the beginning corner, bounded  
 by lands now, or formerly owned by Mrs. Camilla Cooper, Mrs.  
 Mabel C. Arnolds, Mrs. Esther Hughes and others, and being  
 the same tract of land conveyed to the said J.W. Norwood

 this deed to her in compliance with the order of Hon. John E.

 County afo. State bearing date September 20, 1924, rendered in the  
 Case of Sallie J. Arnold against Mabel Arnold, et al.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Sallie J. Arnold and her  
heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, Arthur T. Norwood, do hereby bind  
 myself, my  
 heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Sallie J. Arnold  
and her heirs and assigns, against  
myself, my  
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
