 All that certain piece, tract, or lot of land in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the south east corner of Main and Earle streets, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron Pin at the Southeast corner of Main and Earle streets, and running thence with Earle street S. 70° 27' E. 155 feet and 5 inches to an iron Pin, corner of lot here-to-fare conveyed to W. T. Henderson; thence with line of W. T. Henderson S. 12° 54' W. 50 feet to an iron Pin; thence N. 16° 24' W. 155 feet 5 inches, more or less to an iron Pin on Main Street, thence with Main Street N. 19° 39' E. 60 feet to the beginning corner. Subject, however, to an mutual right of way in alley, ten feet in width, extending from Earle Street in a southerly direction, along the rear of said lot.
