(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Flora L. Garrison and John T. Garrison, all those  
certain piece, parcels, or tracts of land situate,  
lying and being in Greenville County and  
State aforesaid, containing seventy four (74) acres,  
more or less, consisting of two tracts, containing  
sixty acres more or less and fourteen acres more  
or less respectively. The sixty acre tract above  
mentioned was deeded to me by Edmund  
Garrison of Greenville County on the 11th day of  
January 1896, the said deed being recorded in  
the Public Office at Greenville, S.C. on the 21st  
day of March 1916 in Book S.E.B. Page 112, where  
a full and detailed description of said tract  
of land may be found.  
The fourteen acre tract above mentioned  
is a part of a tract of sixteen acres deeded to  
me by J. B. Garrison (two acres having been  
sold to J. R. Ridgeway) the said deed being  
dated April 11th 1902 and recorded in the  
Public Office at Greenville, S.C. on February 21st  
1913 in Vol. 24, page 400, where a full description  
of said tract of land may be found.
