all of our right, title and interest, the same being an undivided  
one-fifth interest, in and to all that certain piece, parcel or  
lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward One of the city  
of Greenville County and State aforesaid, on the corner of  
Lion and Academy Streets, and having the following metes  
and bounds, according to a plat made by C. M. Furman,  
January 15th, 1926; Beginning at corner of College and Academy  
Streets, and running thence with College Street, 8.65; E. 150 feet  
to lion pin; thence S. 19° 45' 4 feet to lion pin; thence N. 65° 10'  
E. 170.5 feet to Academy Street; thence with Academy Street 7.24
