(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said O. L. Adie, all my right title and interest the same being an undivided two-thirds interest in and to all that certain piece parcels or tract of land situate, lying, and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Mill Creek, a water of North Saluda River in Saluda Township, containing 150 acres, more or less, and bounded by the North Saluda River line, separating it from land of Captain W. H. Davis, on the east by Morris' and the south by lands of John Gordon, on the south, west by lands of Early, place and J. M. Bell, and on the east by land of G. Ward, being the same tract of land, described to E. S. Stanton by Border Estate Lumber Company, in a Deed dated December 11th, 1905, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in vol. 20, p. 300, page 740.

All my right title and interest the same being an undivided two-thirds interest in and to all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Saluda Township, containing 22.8 acres, more or less, and having the following parcels and bounds to wit: Beginning at a maple on the south bank of Brady Branch about 80 feet above the mouth of the Phillips Branch river N. 10 E. (1 deg. variation) 34 poles to a stone and pointers, thence N. 18 34 (1 deg. var.) 30 poles to stone and pointers, thence N. 61 deg. (var.) 12 poles to a tree; thence N. 37 West (1 deg. var.) 12 poles and north an old road 16 poles to a stake; thence across road S. 80 West (1 deg. var.) 4 poles, thence with road 20.5 West (1 deg. var.) 6 poles, thence with road 20.5 West (1 deg. var.) 6 poles, thence with road North (1 deg. var.) 6 poles, thence North 62 West (1 deg. var.) 14 poles thence with road North 50 West 5.5 poles, thence with road N. 43 W. (1 deg. var.) 50 poles and 20 links to a black oak on north side of road; thence North 12.5 West (2.5 deg. var.) 45 poles to a small pine, thence North 46 West (1 deg. var.) 21 poles to a rock and pointers, thence North 86 West (1 deg. var.) 20 poles to a rock and pointers thence S. 72 West (1 deg. var.) 22 poles to a rock and pointers thence South 42 West (1 deg. var.) 34 poles to a rock, stake, thence S. 21 deg. var.) 12 poles to a chestnut oak, thence S. 4 W. (1 deg. var.) 12 poles to a maple in the end and thence with this old line S. 56.1 deg. var. 24 poles, thence with the old line S. 42 W.
