(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Great Falls Power Company, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No 5 and 6 of Block One of the yards of Riverside Land Company, according to a plat of said lands made by Carter's Tringell Surveyor, which plat is recorded in the R. M. Co. Office for said County and State, in Plat Book, page 323, said lot being fronting eighty (80) feet, back one hundred twenty five (125) feet, running along the same property Conveyed to the grantor by J. T. Friar, et al being at law of J. T. Friar, by deed dated March 9, 1922, and recorded in Volume 78, page 12.

(6) Company reserves right to authorize taying of gas water, etc.

heirs and assigns, against myself and my wife and heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
