All that certain lot, piece or parcel, of land situate
and being in the state of South Carolina, Greenville
County, in the sixth ward of the city of Greenville,
South Carolina, and designated at lot #3 on Plat made by
U. S. Neves, bearing date March 13th, 1920, and having
according to the Plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron Pin on the East side of Augusta
Street, on the southwest corner of lot #2 (which is
approximately 163.5 feet from the south side of May
Street, and approximately 201.8 feet from the North side
of Tindall Avenue) and running thence N. 89 E. 200 feet
along line of lot #2 to an iron Pin on the line of Stappins
lot #5 (formerly referred to as lot #5 in the H. P. Johnson
survey of the Lehnhardt Property), thence along line
of last mentioned lot S. 30 E. 73.51 feet to an iron Pin
on the line of the Valley lot; thence along last men-
tioned line E. 29 W. 179 feet to an iron Pin on Augusta
Street; thence along said street N. 15 W. 81.8 feet to the
beginning. Recorded Book 103, at Page 102. Being same
lot conveyed to me by S. W. Reams.

This Conveyance is made subject however, to the
following Restrictions: No house shall be erected on
said lot, for any part thereof, costing less than eight
thousand (\$8,000.00) dollars, but this shall not to a
servants house apart from a residence; and these
Premises shall be used in Perpetuity exclusively for residential
purposes for white persons only, and shall never
be sold, rented, or otherwise disposed of to any person
of African descent. But servants of such descent, while
working for white occupants of such Premises may
reside thereon. These conditions are material, and
are conditions subsequent, having substantially affected
the price at which this property is sold. On violation
of either condition, this deed shall be null and void,
and said grantor or their heirs or assigns, may take
possession of the land.

As part payment for above mentioned lot the
purchaser assume one first mortgage in the sum
of Twenty-five (\$2,500.00) hundred dollars, and a second
mortgage of seven hundred (\$700.00) dollars, given by
J. Norwood Cleveland to S. W. Reams and wife, Adams,
respectively.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by S. W. Reams
on the Twenty-third day of October 1920, deed recorded in office of Register
of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 144 of Deeds, Page 271
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, credits and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
