the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
J. M. Ashmore: —  
All that certain lot of land situate in  
Second Ave of the City of Greenville, County and  
State aforesaid, on the west side of North  
Main Street, and being designated on a plat  
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County, in Plat Book 5, at page 225, as Lot No.  
1, together with a certain strip of land lying  
in the rear of said lot which is shown on  
said plat as the southernmost 20 feet of an  
8 foot alley, and being described as follows:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the west side  
of North Main Street at the joint corner of  
Lots Nos. 1 and 2, which point is 88 feet  
south of the southwest corner of the intersection  
of Main and Elford Streets, and running thence  
with the joint line of Lots Nos. 1 and 2,  
N. 61-53 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the  
east side of an 8 foot alley; thence crossing  
said alley, N. 61-53 W. 8 feet to a point on  
the western side of a 40 foot alley in line  
of other property of Mrs. Susie S. Bull, which  
line was formerly the western line of an  
8 foot alley, S. 19-54 W. 26 feet to an iron  
pin; thence crossing said alley, and

61-55 E. 188 feet to an iron pin in the west
