 angles, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the
 West side of Frank street, corner to Caponada's
 house running thence with Caponada's line,
 to the corner of Frank street, thence along
 said line to an iron pipe; thence along
 the same line to another pipe; thence along
 Frank street to the beginning corner being lot
 No. 1 in block 1 in the County named, said lot
 having the office for Greenville
 County, the Post Office, at the corner of Main
 and Market streets, being the
 office of record, recorded to me by J. D. Smith
 my attorney on the 2nd day of September
 1921. And being recorded in R. M. b.
 Case No. 148, as a part of the
 conveyance for this deed the Grantee, Brady
 H. Bettis, assumes and agrees to pay all
 taxes and assessments for street paving due the
 City of Greenville. Such assessments being a
 charge against the property herein described
 and being for current street improvements.
