TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, Greenville County.

Prince, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.H. Prince - his heirs and assigns, all that Piece, Parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the city of Greenville, on the North side of Phett Street, known as Lot No. 7 on Plat of Property of Estate of J.A. Ware, deceased, made by R.E. Walton, Engineer, November 1919, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron Pin on Phett Street at corner of lot no. 6 and running thence with line of lot no. 6 S. 8-49 E. 124-7 feet to an iron Pin in line of lot no. 5; thence S. 71-0 E. 56-4 feet to an iron Pin on line of lot no. 8; thence with line of lot no. 8 S. 8-45 E. 125-0 feet to Phett Street; thence with said Phett Street N. 71-0 E. 56-5 feet to the beginning corner. The Grantor herein agrees to pay all taxes up to and including the year 1927, state, County and City. The grantee W.H. Prince is to pay any Paving assessments for New Paving abutting this lot.
