the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. D. Workman, and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that certain piece parcel, tract of land in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, bounded on the East side by Runcombe Street, being known and designated as lot No. 18, on a plat of property of Hugh Blevins, made by R. E. Dalton, Esq. January 1924, recorded in R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book 5, page 184, and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a point on Runcombe Street, corner of lot No. 17 and 18 and measuring thence N. 20.34 E. 57.53 ft. to point, point corner of lots Nos. 17, 18, 19 and 20, thence West and of lot No. 18, N. 69.27 W. 20 feet to point on line of lot No. 19, thence Westward of lot No. 19, S. 20.34 W. 145.65 ft. to a point on Runcombe Street, thence with Runcombe Street S. 34.30 E. 24.53 feet to the beginning corner, and being the total area conveyed to W.
