the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

R. D. Dobson and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that lot of land in said State and County, in the City of Greer, in Chick Spring Township, just outside of the corporate limits of the Town of Greer, on the south-west side of the Town, and being known as a part of Lot No. 9 in plat made by W. D. Niles, Engineer, April 1912, and having the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on James Street (W. Cannon's corner) and run thence N. 7-15 E. 152.5 feet to an iron pin (A. M. Cannon's and Bobo's corner) thence S. 82-15 E. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence back to iron pin on James Street; thence N. 83.30 W. 52 feet with James Street to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land purchased by E.
