J. R. Smith and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

"All that Piece, Parcel and lot of land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in waters of Turpentine Creek, adjoining lands of J. T. Moore and J. P. Stipp and others, and containing One hundred Sixteen and two-tenths acres, more or less, as shown by a Plat of W. A. Adams, Surveyor, of a survey made by him on May 10, 1918, and being the same land contained in H. L. Sheppard's lot 2, Todd, and having the following lines and bounds, to-wit, beginning at a stone, C. M. Todd's and W. H. Bozeman's corner, and running thence N. 20° 4' E. 18.50 to a stake in center of Public Road; thence along said road S. 69° 22' 0" to a stone, corner of J. P.
