 Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have an interest, in the _____ of _____ County of Greenville and State of S. C. and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property; said sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 10 feet *as clearance necessary for 10th and anchors* and the right to cut all trees that in falling would reach the wires, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor.

Also with further privileges and authority to relocate and reconstruct telephone line to accommodate South Carolina State Highway improvements on said property.
