"All the right, title and interest of Harbro Manufacturing Company in and to all those certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C., and being lots Nos. One (1), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), and Eleven (11) of Block "A", according to plat of Melrose Land Company, recorded in Plat Book "A", page 157, R.
