(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Nora Green,

All that piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in the fork of the Buck Horn and Sandy Flat Roads, East of Paris Mountain, containing thirteen acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a stone in fork of said roads, thence along Sandy Flat Road N. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 4.63 to a stone, thence along same N. 37 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 6.45 to a stone, thence N. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 13.05 to a stone, thence S. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6.35 to a stone on Buck Horn Road, thence along it S. 9.55 to a bend, thence S. 33 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 3.70 to a bend, thence S. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 5.30 to a bend, thence S. 45 E. 1.90 to the beginning corner, and bounded by lands of J. heirs and assigns, against myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Nora Green as such trustee, her


