remains that all the real estate described in the complaint and the cause being at issue came on to be heard on the *3rd* day of *April* 19*29* and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter described and described by *E. Inman* Master in and for the County aforesaid, *American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina* of the premises mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto in this said Court will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. *1*)

Inman* Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said *American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, a Corporation*, *all the right, title, interest and estate of Francis Chiles, Paul Chiles and Frances Chiles of, in and to a strip of land, 100 feet in width over and across that certain tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, mentioned and described in the Complaint and Petition, containing 64 acres, more or less and bounded by Enow River, lands of Mrs. Bessie Eillard Smith, Mrs. Victoria Smith, et al. for the purpose and use of a right of way for Telephone and Telegraph lines, and upon which is to be erected and used poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, insulators and other fixtures and appurtenances that may from time to time be necessary and required in the use and enjoyment of said right of way.*

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said *American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, a Corporation, its successors and assigns forever*, for the uses and purposes as an easement heretofore stated and mentioned and prescribed in the Decree in said cause.
