TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, Fredrick Anderson Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Fredrick Anderson

on or about the 16th day of January in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty nine exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Fredrick Anderson et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 3rd day of July 1929 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Fredrick Anderson for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. 6-715)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, Fredrick Anderson Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Fredrick Anderson, the following described real estate:
All that certain lot of land or situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, and on the north side of First No. Ave., between 3rd Street and 4th Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 as shown on plat of records in the M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Vol. 114, Page 241, and having the following width and length and course and distance as shown by said plat, to-wit:
Beginning at a visible pin on the north side of East 2nd Street, point corner of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence along the line of East 2nd Street, 70.50 ft. to the 1st corner of Lot No. 4; thence along the line of the 1st corner of Lot No. 4, 57.61 ft. to a point in line of property of the War State; thence along the line of the War State property, 70.27 ft. to the corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of the Lot No. 2, 20.25 ft. to the beginning corner.
The lot hereby conveyed is Lot No. 8 as shown in the partition of property of J. W. Watkins and others, and assigned by the Commissioners in partition to Fredrick Anderson. An Alleyway 20 ft. wide along the rear of said lot, and extending from 3rd Street to 4th Street, is reserved for the use and benefit of the five lots in said partition, as shown on the plat hereinabove referred to, and as recommended by the Commissioners in partition."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Fredrick Anderson, his heirs and assigns forever.
