Henry Cleveland, in and to the following described real
estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being a strip 50 ft. in
width, being 25 ft. on each side of the line marked
Proposed Relocation of Greenville & Northern Railway Company
as shown on map showing proposed re-location of Greenville
& Northern Railroad at Marietta, S.C., dated June 13, 1929, and
extending from Station 813-04.5 to station 822-09.6 on
said plat."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-
fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Greenville & Northern Railway
Company, its successors heirs and assigns forever.
