Demanding judgment in the sum above mentioned in the transcript and the cause being at issue came on to be heard in the 31st day of May, 1930 and just proceedings were had thereon as directed in a decree of the said Court whereby it was
 ordered and directed that all the estate heretofore mentioned be partitioned and distributed by E. Inman,
 Master in and for the County aforesaid to Marie P. Haley,
 in the proportion mentioned in the said decree, in the said Court will appear. See Judgment and No. E-1344.
 And whereas the above named Master in and for the County aforesaid has made and executed and delivered to the Clerk of the said Court, E. Inman,
 Master in and for the County aforesaid a Deed reciting and releasing unto the said Marie P. Haley,

The following described real estate:

"All that certain tract of land in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 265 acres, more or less, and being known and designated as Tract No. 6, according to a subdivision and plat of the estate of Jesse L. French, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers in April, 1930. Said tract of land is bounded by lands of J. P. Whitt, W. M. Cloworth, Reaves and Tracts Nos. 4, 5, and 7 of the plat above mentioned and has such metes and bounds and courses and distances as will appear by reference to the above plat, which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "2", Page 270."

The above tract of land represents the divided interest of the grantees, as fixed by the Court, in the Partition Suit herein, under which this deed is made.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Marie P. Haley, her heirs and assigns forever.
