 HAVE GRANTED, released and released, and to these presents DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said

Helen Fisher, the following described real estate:

All that certain tract of land in Highland
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
 containing 50 acres, and having the following lines and
 boundaries and corners and dimensions, as shown by a
 survey and plat, made by J. H. Achire, Surveyor,
 April 14, 1928, to wit:

Beginning at a stone at the Northwest corner of
 said tract and in line of the W. J. Nelson estate
 land and running thence S. 59° 15' E. 1044 feet to a stone,
 thence S. 60° 13' E. 498 feet to a stake, thence S. 79° 07'
 E. 277 1/2 feet to a stake, thence S. 54° 34' E. 112 feet to a
 stake; thence S. 38° 54' E. 103 feet to a stake; thence
 N. 32° E. 956 feet to a stake beside maple; thence
 S. 33° 52' E. 923 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87° 05' W. 1489
 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1° 52' W. 185 3/4 feet to a
