in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mrs. Mattie Walker,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

a corner - boundary and disengaged as lot No. 41 and a part thereof in lot No. 40 and such division known as Block 1, according to plat of said subdivision made by Broder & Geddes, engineer, and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the 1st day of August, 1926, and having the following described and bounded to wit: Beginning at the cornering at the point corners between the intersection of Newland Avenue and Catawba Road, and running thence southwesterly along Newland Avenue 50 ft. 15 feet; thence S. 22-30-9. W. 66 feet back to the corner of lot 1, 40-49. S. 22-6-168 feet more or less, to a w. point over valley, the end with said valley 30 ft. 5-6 ft. 75 feet; thence along line of lot No. 41, 40-49.
