Bradley and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, to-wit, certain pieces, parcels and tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and in the Royal Townships, Section 12-2 miles north of Greenville Court House, on the east side of the Spartanburg Road, and bordering the branch waters of Onoee River, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit;

Beginning at a stone 32 rods and running thence S. 87° 0' 48" E. 12.30 chains to a stake; thence N. 6° E. 13.48 chains to a pointer to an ash down, on a branch thence down and with meanderings of said branch to a Spanish Oak 38 rods; thence to a stone about 200 chains, thence S. 23° W. 24.60 chains to the beginning corner, and containing one acre and three-tenths (18-1/4) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of P.
