All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the Easley, Bridgely Road, being situated about four and a half miles from Greenville Court House, and being a portion of Lot No. 21 and 22 of Book C, 1st Plat of Property of Judge D. Charles, recorded in G. O. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, Page 299. Beginning at a stake on the S E corner of Jesses Archway, and Gordon Street and running thence with Gordon St. N. 71 E. 175 feet to a stake corner lot sold to J. P.
