

He decided, however, to pay damage to the property of the Grant to the extent of the damage caused by this mining, cutting and removing of trees and underbrush as hereinabove provided) caused by the Grant, its successors and assigns, in maintaining or repairing said transmission lines, shall be borne by the Grant, its successors and assigns.

Notwithstanding, however, the Grant or her right to cultivate the grounds between said pole and tower and beneath said wires, provided that such use shall not interfere with or obstruct the rights herein granted.
