

the Railway Company may itself remove the same and restore the said condition of said right of way, but at the expense of the Licensee.

And it is mutually covenanted and agreed that this agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the respective successors heirs and assigns of the parties hereto, as well as upon the parties themselves.
