Know All Men By These Presents: That J. M. N. Miller of said County and State for and in consideration of the terms, conditions and privileges hereinafter expressed; and the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission of Greenville, S. C., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, its successors and assigns, the right, privileges and easement to go in and upon that tract or lot of land situate in \_\_\_\_\_ in said County and State, bounded by lands of Maude Woodside, M. W. Burgess and others and to construct, maintain in and upon and use in and through said premises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances such as machinery, air vents, manholes, blowoff connections and any and every other necessary and proper attachment, pipe lines for sewerage purposes through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter in and upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon of said line, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operations of same.

It is understood and agreed that the easement herein granted shall extend throughout the property of the grantor about 1274 feet, and shall be of such width as the grantee shall deem necessary for the purposes herein specified, and that the damage for which Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission may be held liable shall be confined to that arising from the use of this strip only, and nothing beyond.

It is further agreed that this easement is to be used only during the construction or repair of said pipe line and with the exception of the right of Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, its agents, servants and employees, successors and assigns, to inspect said pipe line and to enter at any point and make repairs, the owner has the same privilege and right as he now has to cultivate and use the land, provided, however, this shall not apply to such part wherein the top of the pipe is less than eighteen (18) inches underground.
