On Paris Mountain and Johnson, as the home place of the grantor. The easement over said tract of land, however, is simply to apply along the power line as constructed at that time over said property and no changes in said line or make except the replacement of existing poles, without the written consent of the grantor, his successors or assigns.

and to construct and maintain, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power of electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to keep said right of way clear of all structures for the space of thirty-four feet (34) on each side of the center of said power line, with the further right to cut away and keep clear of said line and wires all trees or other like obstructions that might in any way endanger the proper operation of same.

The right to cut away and keep clear said line of all trees and other obstructions is limited to the extent that before any employee of the Southern Public Utilities Company enters upon the property for this last mentioned purpose that the consent of the owner shall be first obtained before any tree, shrub or other obstruction is cleared away; and the owner reserves the right to the clearing of the
