KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Mamie G. Turner, W. M. Guest, Ethel G. Hodges, Ida G. Bramlett, and Jimmie G. Humphries, of the County of Greenville,

and other valuable considerations,

to us  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Leila Guest  
in hand paid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Leila Guest, her heirs and assigns, all our undivided interest (being the one fourth undivided interest of our mother, Emma Guest, who died intestate July 12th, 1921, leaving the grantor and grantee herein as her sole heirs at law and distributees, said heirs all being of legal age), in the following described real estate; All that certain Parcel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Saluda Township and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake in the State Road, at the crossing of Horse Branch, and running thence N. 75° 3' W. 2270 ch. to a stake in branch; thence S. 23° 3' E. 5.24 to stone on left of branch; thence S. 38 W. 2.33 to stone on left bank of branch; thence down said branch 17.32 chs. to North Saluda river; thence down said river 5.10 to a stone on left bank of river; thence S. 41° 3' E. 43.50 to stone; thence N. 6 W. 3.05 to stone; thence N. 15 E. 18.00 chs. to Chestnut; thence N. 9° 3' E. 12.50 to stake in State Road; thence along said road in a northerly direction 29.67 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing one hundred five (105) acres, more or less, and being part of the land conveyed to W. A. Hodges by Davis W. Hodges Dec. 22, 1890 and recorded in Deed Book "D" at Page 118.

The intention of this deed is to convey only the undivided interest which our mother, Emma Guest, owned in said land before her death, and not the interest of any of the grantors, which was acquired by deed.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Leila Guest

her heirs and assigns, against  
ourselves and

our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
