

Received of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina One \$200,000.00 Dollars, in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said company, its associates and allied companies, their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, the right, privilege and authority to construct, erect, construct, operate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over and pass under the property which I own or in which I have any interest in the Township of Butler, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of Mrs. Bessie Dillard Smith, Mrs. W. S. Smith, et. al. and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets or highway adjoining the said property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables clear at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and for any in conduit wires and cables of any other company; and with the further right to cut down and to keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within 25 feet of said line. I the grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby covenants that no wire line will be erected or permitted on said property which in the judgment of the grantee, its successors and assigns, will interfere with its service or endanger its lines and that no inflammable structure will be erected or permitted on said property within 25 feet of said lines. Said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted and for all wood & timber damage.
