

property, with the right to trim from time to time any trees along said line so as to keep the wires and cables clear at least thirty-six inches and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company; and with the further right to cut down and to keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within 50 feet of said line the grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby covenants that no wire line will be erected or permitted on said property which in the judgment of the grantor, its successors and assigns, will interfere with its service or endanger its lines and that no inflammable structure will be erected or permitted on said property within 50 feet of said line. Said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein granted, and for all wood and timber damage to pay damages to fences or crops during construction of line.
