 poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own, or in which I have
 an interest, in the _____ of _____ County of Greenville and State of
 S. C. and upon and along the roads, streets of highways adjoining the said property; said
 sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attach-
 ment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right
 to trim and cut trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least
 5 feet, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors,
 and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full
 payment therefor.
