Wynn and Mamie Lee Wynn, all unmarried, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations to us in hand paid by Minnie Wynn, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell out and release unto the said Miss Minnie Wynn, all our right, title and interest in all that certain tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 44.6 acres, more or less being the same land inherited by us from our father C.F. Wynn, and being the same tract of land conveyed to him by his father, Jerry Wynn by deed recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book 28 at page 6, dated Jan. 4, 1913, and therein described as follows: Beginning at a stone on Finley Bridge Road, and running thence with said road as a line N 58 W 8.00 to bend; Thence N 48 W 17.90 to stake in said road; thence S 59 W 7.30 to R.O. Stump; thence S 13 1/2 E 7.00 to a stone; thence S 67 3/4 E 4.50 to stake on branch; thence down said branch as a line 16.20 to stake in fork of branch; thence up the Shockey branch S 66 E 2.60 to stake at fork of branch; thence up said branch as a line N 89 E 13.37 to stake in branch; thence N 30 E 14.86 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands now or lately belonging to Mrs. Shockey, John B. Heater and others, and being part of the land conveyed to Jerry Wynn by Elizabeth Dixon by deed recorded in said office in Book R.P. Page 567.
