Goenell may have in lots nos 143, 144 and 145, excepting said two foot strip taken from the eastern side of lot no 143.

Being the same lot of land conveyed by P. D. Goenell to Charles D. Prew on January 9th, 1923, and recorded in the M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 77, page 4.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have And To Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Amy Prew, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Amy Prew, her Heir and Assigns, against me and my Heir and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
